- **Hot and Cold Bible**

Hide a Bible somewhere in the room. Say, "We learned about a very important book today. Do you know the name of the book? That's right! The Bible—God's Word. I've hidden the Bible somewhere in the room, and we're going to play Hot and Cold to find it. If you get close to the Bible, I'll say, 'Hot,' and if you're far away from it, I'll say, 'Cold.' Let's start looking!"

- **God's Word Has Power**

Write "God's Word Has Power" on a piece of paper and gather finger paints. You can also make your own by following the recipe found [HERE](#). Say, "This paper says 'God's Word Has Power.' We learned in The Big God Story all about that power. We're going to listen to a song and finger paint on the paper." Talk with kids about the things they heard in The Big God Story today. "God's Word tells us all about God's love. Does God love you? Yes, He does. How big is God's love for you? Soooooo big! Who made you? God did. Is God always with you? Yes, He is. All of these things are true, and we can read them in the Bible!" Turn on some upbeat worship music and demonstrate how to paint. Then encourage them to do the same.
