- Great News Megaphones

Gather paper (heavier weight such as cardstock or construction paper), markers, stickers and tape or a stapler. Say, **"When Jesus rose from the dead, it was very exciting. Jesus told Mary to tell everyone that He was alive. Today, we're going to make megaphones to help us tell everyone that Jesus is alive. First, we're going to decorate our papers and then we will roll them into megaphones."** Allow your child to decorate their paper and then use the tape or stapler to secure it into a cone shape.

- Celebration Parade

Have your megaphones from the previous activity ready. Say, **"We're going to have a parade using our megaphones. We're going to march around shouting, 'Jesus is alive!' We want everyone to hear the exciting news about Jesus!"** Have your family members take turns leading the Celebration Parade!

- Song of Celebration

Cue up "Celebrate" by TruWorship (Video link [HERE](#)). Say, **"I'm so happy Jesus is alive! I'm so happy that it makes me want to dance! Will you dance with me to celebrate that Jesus is alive?"** Sing and dance with your family to celebrate!
