Say, **"When the disciples told Thomas that Jesus had risen from the dead, Thomas doubted until he was able to see Jesus for himself. Today we are going to hear some facts, and you will have to determine whether they are true or false."** Mark one side of your room as the true side and one as the false side. When you ask a question your family will move to the side they think is correct. Here are a few questions to get you started, feel free to add more of your own.

- Jesus is alive, even though we can't see Him. (True)
- Fish breathe under the water. (True)
- There are 66 books in the Bible. (True.)
- The Bible is called a sword. (True. Ephesians 6:17)
