Fishes and Loaves

Print the template (found <u>HERE</u>) and gather scissors, glue and construction paper. Cut out the loaves and fishes or assist your child in doing so. Say, "Jesus cared so much for the people in the Big God Story that He fed them when there wasn't enough food. How many fish were there? (Two) How many loaves of bread were there? (Five) Can you glue the fish and loaves onto your paper? Who can we tell about how Jesus cares for you and them?" Help your child share the story of Jesus' care with someone else!

Food I Like to Eat

Gather scissors, glue, a paper plate and grocery flyers.

Alternately you could draw a plate on a piece of paper. Say, "I love to eat different kinds of food. Do you? Here are pictures of different kinds of food. Do you see any that you like? Let's pick out the ones you like and glue them on the paper plate." Assist your child with cutting and gluing. "Did you know that Jesus cares about you so much that He gives you food to eat? I love how Jesus always takes care of us!"
