- Jesus is Powerful

Print the Face Template (found [HERE](#)) and gather googly eyes, glue and markers. Say, "**Jesus helped the man who was blind. Can you point to your eyes? Great job. Let's look at the picture together. What's missing on the face? This face is missing eyes. I have googly eyes for us to stick on the face. What else does this face need? It needs some color. Let's color the faces together. Each time we see this picture, we can remember that Jesus is powerful.**" Color the picture together and add the googly eyes.

- What Color Do You See?

Gather paper of various colors. Say, "**When the man was blind, he couldn't see any colors. Jesus healed the blind man. Then the man could see colors for the very first time. Let's pretend that we can't see. When I count to three, open your eyes and see what color I'm holding. Let's practice. Close your eyes and cover them with your hands. One, two, three. Open your eyes. Hold up a sheet of colored paper. What color do you see?** Allow kids to respond. **That's right, great job! Let's play again.**"
