With our expanded facility we are setting up a group of volunteers to make minor repairs and keep our facility in God-honoring condition. Please contact Henry Klassen if you would be interested.



East Side's W.O.W. Ministry launched "Operation Outreach" on February 3<sup>rd</sup> of this year. One of the local agencies that we had partnered with contacted us almost immediately. A young mom with 5 small children was in need of several basic life necessity items. We put the requests out to you as a congregation and did you all ever respond! Over 20 bags of clothing, cleaning supplies, personal items, towels, bedding, books, games, gift cards, and two beds were donated and were delivered as of today!! What an incredible outpouring of love! Along with these

items, we will be helping the family with some housecleaning chores and hopefully when restrictions are lifted, we would like some of our East Side ladies to come alongside and mentor this mom.

We have also been able to surprise an older single woman who moved provinces with almost nothing of her own, with a bed and clothing.

While connecting with these agencies, we learned that the most needed item was socks. Thus we held East Side's 1st Annual Sock Drive and we set our goal at collecting 100 pairs. To date we have delivered over 305 pairs of socks to local groups and schools and we still have up till this Sunday to take donations!!

We would like to thank everyone for being so incredibly generous and helping us to be the hands and feet of Christ within our community!
