- I Can Make a Heart

Make or buy play dough and gather rolling pins and heart shaped cookie cutters. Show your child the cookie cutter and ask, "What shape is this? Can you help me make some hearts with our play dough? Hearts can help us to think about love. Who is someone you love? Who loves you? I know someone very special who loves you too. God loves you!"

- Celebration Parade

Gather toy instruments and cue some upbeat worship music. Say, "One thing we can do to celebrate our God who loves us is to have a parade. Let's get in a line, and I'm going to give everyone an instrument. When the music starts, we'll march around the room and play our instruments to celebrate that God loves you, me, and everyone in the whole world."

- Pass the Love Around

Print the Heart Template [HERE](#) (or draw your own), cue some worship music and gather your family. Say, "What am I holding? That's right—a heart. It says 'God Loves Me.' We're going to play a game and pass the heart around a circle. When the music starts, you're going to give the heart to the person sitting next to you, and then he'll give it to the person next to him. We'll keep passing the heart until the music stops. When the music stops, the person holding the heart will stand up. Then we'll say "God loves (insert the name of the child holding the heart)."

Blessing

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Read **Psalm 107:15** "Let them give thanks to the Lord for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for mankind."
