Worries Falling Away

Gather 10 disposable or plastic cups and two balls (tennis or similar). Stack the cups in a pyramid and place the balls approximately 10 feet away. Say, "Jesus frees us from feeling like we need to worry about tomorrow. We no longer have to hold on to what we think we need; we can allow those worries to fall away. We're going to play a game where we try to get objects to fall away by knocking them over with a ball." Take turns rolling the ball and trying to knock over all the cups. Re-stack the cups for the next person. After the game, discuss: "Why does Jesus tell us not to worry? Have you ever experienced Jesus freeing you from being worried? Can you tell us about it?" (Alternately, bring out your nerf blasters for this!)
