Bubble Pop

Gather some bubble wrap and a bottle of bubbles. Put your bubble wrap on the floor. Say, "Today we learned about Samuel using his ears to hear God's voice. There are so many things in the world for us to hear. Some things make noise and some things do not. We have two kinds of bubbles to play with. We have bubble wrap. When you walk or stomp on it, it pops. Demonstrate for your child. We also have blowing bubbles. When we pop these bubbles, they don't make much noise. Demonstrate popping a blowing bubble. Let's all have some fun with the bubbles. You can stomp on the bubble wrap or pop the bubbles when I blow them."

Freeze Dance

Cue up some upbeat worship music. Say, "God made you and me. He gave us ears to hear, mouths to sing, and feet to dance. Let's have a dance party. When you hear the music stop you should stop moving and stand still until the music starts again."
