Preschool Lesson Part 1: November 22, 2020

God is Worshipped

Psalm 27:6; 30:11; 95:2; 98:4; 108:1; 149:3

Musical Glasses

Gather a metal spoon and 5-10 drinking glasses filled with different amounts of water. Say, "We can worship God together. We can use our voices to sing or instruments to make music. We're going to have fun with some glasses full of water by making some music with the spoon. We have to tap them gently. Watch me make some music, and then you can have a turn."

Demonstrate for your child how to gently use the spoon to tap the sides of each glass and listen to the different sounds they make.

Finger Paint Fun

Gather finger paint, a zip-top bag and packing tape. Prepare by putting a few different colors of paint into the bag and sealing the top with packing tape. Don't mix the paints! Say, "Who made you? God did! God used many beautiful colors to make you! We can thank Him and worship Him for all of the beautiful colors and beautiful people He made. Let's sing "Jesus Loves the Little Children" while we paint with our fingers. We can watch the colors get all mixed up." (Finger painting without the mess!)

Songs of Celebration

Cue up a worship video (great suggestions <u>HERE</u>). Say, **"God made us to worship Him. We can praise Him with our voices, with music, and even by dancing. When we give Him praise, He is worshipped. Let's all stand up and worship and praise the Lord again."** Have fun worshiping together!

Blessing

Read **Psalm 95:6** "Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the LORD our Maker."
