- **Fingerprint Science**

Gather paper, an ink pad and a magnifying glass. Say, "God made each of us special and one-of-a-kind. He even made our fingerprints to be different from each other. Do you know where your fingerprints are? Turn your hand over and look at your fingertips. That's where you can find your fingerprints. Press your finger on the ink pad and then on the paper and you'll be able to see your very own fingerprint." Add your fingerprint beside your child's. Ask, "Is your fingerprint the same or different from mine? What do you see when you look through the magnifying glass?"

- **God Made Me Flag**

Print the Flag Template [HERE](#) (or view and make your own). Gather stickers, art supplies and craft sticks or straws. Say, "God made you. Isn't that exciting? Let's make flags that you can wave to tell everyone that God made every person. When you're done, we'll put a craft stick/straw on it so you can wave it back and forth to celebrate."

- **Dough People**

Gather or make some play dough. Say, "Today we're going to make some dough people. Let's see how we each make very different people." You might need to demonstrate how to roll the dough into a ball for a head and into shapes for arms and legs. Have fun!
