Brown & Blue Sort

Gather 2 pieces of paper (one brown, one blue) and various items from around your home that are blue and brown (buttons, beads, crayons, blocks, etc.) Place your paper on the table and mix up the blue and brown items beside. Say, "God parted the Red Sea for Moses and the Israelites. He separated the water so the people could cross to the other side on dry ground. We have sheets of blue paper and brown paper on the table. We also have a bunch of brown and blue things. Can you help me sort them? Let's put all of the brown items on the brown paper and everything that is blue on the blue paper."

Windy Paint

Gather paper, washable paint and a straw. Cover your table and get a paint shirt/smock for your child. Take some of your paint and mix it with water until it is the consistency of milk. Add a small amount of paint to the paper. Say, "God sent a big, strong wind to blow on the Red Sea. We're going to use our straws to make a strong wind to blow the paint on our paper. First, let's all pick up our straws and practice blowing through them. Next, let's point our straws at the paper and blow and watch what happens to the paint."

Read **Psalm 150:6** Let everything that has breath praise the Lord. Praise the Lord.
