- **Song of Celebration**

Say, "When the people got hungry, God cared for His people and fed them. God cares for you and me. Let's sing a song all about who God is! Let's stand up and sing to God." Play "He is God" [HERE](#) and worship together!

- **Find the Manna**

Gather a basket and some cotton balls. Spread the cotton balls around the room. Say, "When the people needed food, did God care for them and send them food? Yes, He did. God gave them manna to eat every morning. We have pretend manna all over the floor. Can you help find it and put it in the basket?" Demonstrate how to put the "manna" in the basket. If you have more than one child, consider getting an extra basket and turning it into a race!

- **Baskets Overflowing**

Print the Basket Template [HERE](#) (or view and draw your own) and gather glue sticks and cotton balls. Say, "We've been talking about how God cares for us. God cared for Moses and the people when they needed food. God cares about us too. We're going to glue the manna onto our own baskets!" While your child is working, ask: "What are ways God cares for us? Does He give us people to care for us? Does He give us friends who care for us?"

- **Snack Time**

Tie a snack into the lesson. Give your child bread, crackers, cereal flakes or mini marshmallows to be the manna. While you are eating, ask: "What are ways God cares for us? Does He give us people to care for us? Does He give us friends who care for us?"
