Genesis 1-2:3

Bubbly Colors

Gather a plate or tray, baking soda, cups with water, food coloring and eye droppers. Cover your plate with baking soda and add food coloring to the water in the cups. Say, "What is your favorite color? Who made all of the colors? That's right—God did! We have some baking soda and a cup of water. What color is the water? You get to use the eyedropper to suck up the water and then squirt it onto the baking soda. Watch and see what happens."

• Stars in the Sky

Gather black or dark blue construction paper, white or yellow paint and cotton swabs. (Optional: use chalk instead of paint) Say, "Today in The Big God Story, we learned that God made our world. Some of the first things He made were the stars in the sky. What color paper do you have in front of you? We're going to paint stars in the night sky. Dip your cotton swab into the paint and make dots on the paper. Let's see how many stars will be in your sky!"

Song of Celebration

Say, "We know that God made our world. He gave us so many beautiful things to see and touch and hear. When we look around and see all that God gives us, we can worship God and thank Him for all of His gifts." Cue "Everybody, Everywhere" <u>HERE</u> and worship together!

Blessing:

Read **Psalm 19:1** The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands.
